

# Colorado, 2009

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- **CASES:** Colorado reported 105 cases in 2009.
- **RATES:** Colorado ranked 32 among 50 states; Washington, DC; and 3 territories with 2.1 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.6 cases per 100,000 population.

## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Colorado, the rate among males was 4.0 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.8 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.2 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.4 per 100,000.


## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In Colorado, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 1.9 among whites, 4.8 among blacks, 2.4 among Hispanics, 0.7 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 7.2 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.
- The rate among blacks was 2.5 times that of whites.
- The rate among Hispanics was 1.3 times that of whites.
- The rate among American Indians/Alaska Natives was 3.8 times that of whites.


## Congenital syphilis

- **CASES:** Colorado reported 0 cases in 2009.
- **RATES:** Colorado had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 10.0 cases per 100,000.
