

Puerto Rico, 2009

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 227 cases in 2009.
- RATES: Puerto Rico ranked 12 among 50 states; Washington, DC; and 3 territories with 5.7 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 4.6 cases per 100,000 population.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Puerto Rico, the rate among males was 10.8 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 7.8 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 1.1 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 1.4 per 100,000.


Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Puerto Rico reported 5 cases in 2009.
- RATES: Puerto Rico ranked 11 among among 34 areas (33 states and 1 territory) reporting congenital syphilis cases with a rate of 10.3 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 10.0 cases per 100,000.
