

North Dakota, 2012

Primary and secondary syphilis

- **CASES:** North Dakota reported 4 cases in 2012.
- **RATES:** North Dakota ranked 47 among 50 states reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 0.6 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 5.0.

Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In North Dakota, the rate among males was 1.2 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 9.3.
- The rate among females was 0.0 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In North Dakota, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.5 among whites, 0.0 among blacks, 0.0 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asians, 0.0 among Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.


Congenital syphilis

- **CASES:** North Dakota reported 0 cases in 2012.
- **RATES:** North Dakota had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 7.8.
