

Colorado, 2013

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Colorado reported 163 cases in 2013.
- RATES: Colorado ranked 33 among 50 states reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 3.1 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 5.5.

Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Colorado, the rate among males was 6.1 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 10.3.
- The rate among females was 0.2 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In Colorado, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 2.6 among whites, 5.0 among blacks, 3.6 among Hispanics, 1.4 among Asians, 15.8 among Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islanders, and 3.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.
- The rate among blacks was 1.9 times that of whites.
- The rate among Hispanics was 1.4 times that of whites.
- The rate among Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islanders was 6.1 times that of whites.
- The rate among American Indians/Alaska Natives was 1.2 times that of whites.


Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Colorado reported 0 cases in 2013.
- RATES: Colorado had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.7.
