

# Mississippi, 2013

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Mississippi reported 78 cases in 2013.
- RATES: Mississippi ranked 37 among 50 states reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 2.6 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 5.5.

## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Mississippi, the rate among males was 4.1 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 10.3.
- The rate among females was 1.2 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9.


## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In Mississippi, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.1 among whites, 6.5 among blacks, 1.2 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asians, 0.0 among Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.
- The rate among blacks was 55.9 times that of whites.
- The rate among Hispanics was 10.1 times that of whites.


## Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Mississippi reported 0 cases in 2013.
- RATES: Mississippi had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.7.
