

Vermont, 2013

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Vermont reported 3 cases in 2013.
- RATES: Vermont ranked 49 among 50 states reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 0.5 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 5.5.

Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In Vermont, the rate among males was 1.0 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 10.3.
- The rate among females was 0.0 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9.


Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In Vermont, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.5 among whites, 0.0 among blacks, 0.0 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asians, 0.0 among Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.


Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Vermont reported 0 cases in 2013.
- RATES: Vermont had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.7.
