

# West Virginia, 2013

## Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: West Virginia reported 15 cases in 2013.
- RATES: West Virginia ranked 46 among 50 states reporting at least one case of P&S syphilis with 0.8 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 5.5.

## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by sex

- In West Virginia, the rate among males was 1.2 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 10.3.
- The rate among females was 0.4 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9.


## Rates of primary and secondary syphilis, by race/ethnicity

- In West Virginia, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.6 among whites, 6.2 among blacks, 0.0 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asians, 0.0 among Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.
- The rate among blacks was 9.8 times that of whites.


## Congenital syphilis

- CASES: West Virginia reported 0 cases in 2013.
- RATES: West Virginia had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.7.
