The Jack N. Spencer Award, initially presented to Mr. Jack N. Spencer in December 1999, will be presented at the STD Prevention Conference to an individual who best meets the criteria described below.

The award script reads as follows: “The Jack N. Spencer Award is given to honor individuals for a career of exceptional contributions to excellence in sexually transmitted disease prevention characterized by outstanding commitment to science based programs, continuous innovation, and profound commitment to helping people.”

You are invited to nominate a person who meets these criteria.

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Individuals can nominate one (or more) person for this award. However, only one nominee and nominator name can be on each nomination letter. Supporting documentation shall not exceed two pages, typed in 12-character font.

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**NAME OF NOMINEE:**

*(Nominee may be living or deceased; employed by CDC at headquarters or in the field, employed by a state or local health department, or by a non-governmental agency. See specific criteria below.)*

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**CAREER PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE:**

*(Nominee must have at least 20 years of experience in STD prevention. Please describe nominee’s professional experience.)*

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**SCIENCE BASED PROGRAMS:**

*(Nominee must have demonstrated his or her commitment to developing, using, or supporting science based STD prevention program services, e.g., translating research into action, using behavioral and epidemiological data to direct program, etc. Please describe at least two or more significant examples of this activity, especially when the actions of the nominee contributed to national STD prevention efforts.)*

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**CONTINUOUS INNOVATION:**

*(Nominee must have demonstrated his or her commitment to continuously employing creative ways of conducting STD prevention services to enhance results, e.g., developing unique partnerships and collaborations, using alternative interventions, etc. Please describe at least two or more examples of “continuous innovation” in STD prevention programs demonstrated by the nominee.)*
