

What is PrEP?

PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) is medicine that is highly effective at preventing HIV when taken as prescribed. PrEP can be pills or shots.



Is PrEP safe?

PrEP is safe for women to take, and can even be taken during pregnancy or while breastfeeding. There are also no known interactions between PrEP and hormone-based birth control methods, so it is safe to use both at the same time

PrEP is for Women. PrEP is for Us.



How do I pay for PrEP?

Most insurance plans and state Medicaid programs cover PrEP. That means you can't be charged for your PrEP medication, clinic visits, or lab tests you need to maintain your prescription. There are also programs that can help you get PrEP for free.



Your sexual health is important.

Talk to a health care provider you are comfortable with to see if PrEP is right for you.
