

**People arriving in the United States as part of
Uniting for Ukraine must be tested for tuberculosis (TB).**

Who should be tested?



All people two years of age or older will need to be tested for TB by getting an interferon-gamma release assay (IGRA) test within 90 days after arrival to the United States. An IGRA is a blood test to tell if a person has been infected with TB germs.

How do you get tested?

Your local or state health department may be able to provide you with a TB blood test or refer you to other testing locations. You may also be able to get a TB blood test at a healthcare provider's office or a local laboratory.

TB testing costs may vary by location.

How much does testing cost?



Check with your local health department for information on TB testing costs. TB screening may be available for free or at a reduced cost at local and state health departments.
