DO'S AND DON'TS TO PREVENT FALSE-POSITIVE AFB SMEARS



DC

- Use only clean, new slides
- ✓ Use only pencils, bar codes, or other methods that remain legible during staining
- ✓ Verify slides are correctly labeled with laboratory or patient identifiers
- Ascertain that reagents and rinse water are free of AFB
- ✓ Filter stains if precipitants are present
- Use filtered or deionized water
- ✓ Use a negative control slide
- Wipe oil immersion lens after each AFB-positive smear



DON'T

- Attempt to reuse slides
- Allow slides to touch each other
- 8 Bulk stain or use staining jars
- Use standing water to rinse slides
- Allow microscopists who have not been evaluated for competency to report smear results
- **⊗** Use unfiltered water to rinse
