We now see a wide shot of Sharon walking on a treadmill. She turns to the camera and speaks.

SHARON: But walking every day makes me feel like myself again.

The spot cuts to a close-up shot of Sharon speaking into the camera with her stoma clearly within frame.

SHARON: Well, almost.

The spot cuts to the art card, which reads "Smoking causes throat cancer."
