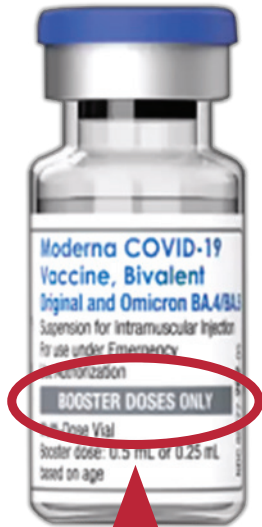


Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine

Bivalent Vaccine Vial Infographic

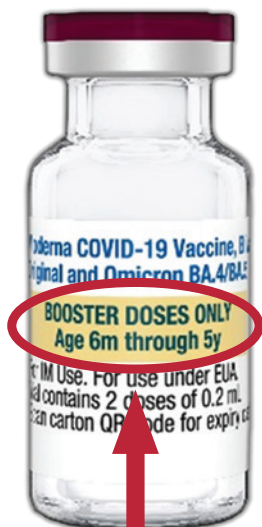


There are 2 presentations of Moderna bivalent COVID-19 vaccine outlined below. Determining which presentation and dosage to use is based on the recipient's age and vaccination history and the presence of moderate or severe immune compromise.



“Booster Doses Only” does not apply

Administer vaccine from this vial based on age, vaccination history and the presence of moderate or severe immune compromise.	
Age: 6 months through 5 years	Vaccination history: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> NEVER been vaccinated with ANY COVID-19 vaccine Previously vaccinated with 1 or more dose of monovalent COVID-19 vaccine* Previously vaccinated with 1 dose of bivalent vaccine*
Age: 6 years and older	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unvaccinated Previously vaccinated with 1 or more doses of only monovalent COVID-19 vaccine* Previously vaccinated with 1 or more doses of bivalent vaccine*
Route	Intramuscular (IM) injection
Dosage	
6 months through 11 years	0.25 mL/25 µg
12 years and older	0.5 mL/50 µg
Note: For inventory purposes each vial contains 5 doses regardless which dosage is withdrawn.	



“Booster Doses Only” does not apply

Administer vaccine from this vial based on age, vaccination history and the presence of moderate or severe immune compromise.	
Age: 6 months through 4 years	Vaccination history: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously vaccinated with 2 or more doses of monovalent COVID-19 vaccine *
Route	Intramuscular (IM) injection
Dosage	0.2 mL/10 µg
Note: This vial contains 2 doses. It is NOT a single dose vial.
