

STORE IT RIGHT

Protect Every Dose, Protect Every Patient

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Keep your storage units and vaccines within the temperature ranges recommended by the manufacturer. Manufacturer package inserts and product-specific guidance supersede general storage recommendations.
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At the start of each workday, check and record storage unit minimum/maximum (min/max) temperatures for each storage unit. If your device does not show min/max temperatures, check and record the current temperature at least twice a day (at the start and end of the workday).
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Never freeze diluents. All diluents may be stored in the refrigerator, and some may also be kept at room temperature.
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Use a log or [label](#) to track the beyond-use date (BUD)¹ for any vaccine transitioned from frozen to refrigerated states.

Ultra-cold Freezer	
Store between -90°C and -60°C (-130°F and -76°F).

- Footnotes
1.

Some vaccines must be used before the expiration date because they have a BUD—an earlier deadline after which the product should not be used.
2.

RSV monoclonal antibodies are stored using the same cold chain principles as vaccines, following guidance in the manufacturer’s package insert.
3.

M-M-R II may be stored in either the refrigerator or the freezer.
4.

Spikevax’s BUD: may be refrigerated for up to 60 days.
5.

mNexspike’s BUD: may be refrigerated for up to 90 days.
6.

Jynneos must be stored frozen at -25°C to -15°C (-13°F to +5°F), which differs from the standard frozen range. BUD: may be refrigerated for 4 weeks; certain lots received an extension to 8 weeks.
7.

mResvia must be stored frozen at -40°C to -15°C (-13°F to +5°F), which differs from the standard frozen range. BUD: may be refrigerated for up to 90 days.
8.

Comirnaty vials should not be stored in a standard freezer. BUD: may be refrigerated for up to 10 weeks.
