The Learning Community is a \$7M CDC collaboration effort bringing together 500+ partners funded through the *Partnering for Vaccine Equity* program—from local community-based organizations to large medical associations and national foundations — to share knowledge and best practices to achieve vaccine equity.

# Immediate and Long-Term Capacity Building

The Learning Community allows partners to share their expertise, learn from other partners, and access resources, including best practices and ready-to-use communications products. Through group learning, one-on-one coaching with subject matter experts (SMEs), and data-informed technical assistance, the Learning Community will help them address urgent COVID-19 vaccination needs and strengthen their partnerships and capacity to address broader long-standing inequities in adult vaccination.

Program management, collaboration, reporting, and improvement across Learning Community activities and partners

#### **Technical Assistance**

National organizations provide technical assistance to state, local, and community organizations through one-on-one coaching and access to SMEs.

State, local, and community organizations receive tailored coaching, connections, and lessons learned from national organizations.

## Peer-to-Peer & Group Learning

Group Learning Manager [Urban Institute] oversees **peer-to-peer and group learning activities** and an online collaboration site.

State, local, and community-based organizations **build capacity and partnerships** through a schedule of virtual webinars, workshops, and office hours.

### Materials Management

Materials Hub Manager [CDC Foundation] oversees management of material collection, evaluation, and distribution, as well as a materials hosting platform.

State, local, and community organizations have easily accessible and usable materials to inform and accelerate their work on the ground.
