Three-part Approach to Building Vaccine Equity Evidence Base

Partner organizations will apply a **three-part approach to build the evidence base** for effective vaccine equity strategies by identifying effective strategies in an environmental scan, partnering with local organizations to implement and evaluate the strategies, and codifying and disseminating the evaluation findings in evidence-informed toolkits and other materials.

Evaluation-focused Organizations to Use Unique Environmental Scanning Method

Each organization will conduct an environmental scan of peer-reviewed literature and other sources to identify effective strategies in vaccine equity, including work that recipients and subrecipients within the *Partnering for Vaccine Equity* program network are carrying out. Using that inventory, **evaluation-focused organizations can distill the strategies into promising practices for vaccine equity that can be applied to other adult immunization programs.** Collecting innovative strategies and implementing them will not only build the vaccine equity evidence base, but also serve as a catalyst to reducing disparities in COVID-19 and influenza vaccination.
