

Vaccine Code Set Release Notes

Publication Date: June 2018

Several new CVX codes have been created for foreign use vaccines:

- 190 – Typhoid conjugate vaccine (non-US)
- 191 - meningococcal A polysaccharide vaccine (non-US)
- 192 - meningococcal AC polysaccharide vaccine (non-US)

These codes can be used to document historical administrations which happened outside of the United States. Keep in mind that the existence of a CVX code for a foreign vaccine does not necessarily mean that the vaccine is valid for satisfying ACIP or other recommendations.

CVX 148 (Meningococcal C/Y-HIB PRP) has had its status set to Inactive because the Menhibrix vaccine has been discontinued. This CVX may still be used to record historic vaccine administration.

CVX 23 (Plague vaccine) has had its status set to Inactive because no plague vaccine is available in the US market.

Several CVX codes have had their name updated:

- CVX 132 – updated to remove asterisks
- CVX 189 – updated to explicitly reference the CDC adjuvant abbreviation of CpG

The comments for CVX 08 and 43 have been updated to remove an inadvertent (trademark) character.

Three MVX codes (DSI, REB and VET) have been retired as they do not currently distribute vaccine.

Comments for MVX codes MED and OTC have been updated to indicate their parent company.

The mapping from CPT 90747 has been updated to CVX 43 from CVX 44. This CPT code is the 4-dose series for dialysis. This series is for Engerix-B which uses CVX code 43 rather than CVX 44 which is the Recombivax dialysis formulation. Note that CPT code 90740 remains mapped to CVX 44.

Several linkages for retired influenza NDC codes have been updated to correct a previous error:

- NDC 66521-114-02 (UoU and UoS are the same) is now associated with CVX 140
- NDCs 76420-482-01 and 76420-483-01 (UoU and UoS are the same) are now associated with CVX 150
- NDCs 76420-470-10 and 76420-471-01 (UoU and UoS are the same) are now associated with CVXs 141 and 140 respectively as well as MVX code NOV

The linkage for 42515-002-01 (same UoU and UoS) has been updated from 508 to 509 to fix a duplicate linker ID.

NDC 21695-413-01 (same UoU and UoS) is now associated with MVX code MBL.

NDC 62195-051-01 (UoU)/62195-051-10 (UoS) is now associated with MVX code VAL.

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New NDCs (49281-718-10 (UoS) and 49281-718-88 (UoU)) for Flublok Quadrivalent (manufacturer by Protein Sciences and distributed by Sanofi) have been added. These NDC codes are for products for the 2017-2018 flu season.

OuterStartDate (UoS) and UseUnitStartDate (UoU) were added to the following active NDCs where an FDA marketing start date was available:

- 58160-976-20 (UoS)
- 58160-976-06 (UoS)
- 58160-976-02 (UoU)
- 58160-828-03 (UoU)
- 62195-051-01 (UoU)

Retired NDC Codes:

The FDA indicates that the following NDCs are no longer active as of 4/30/2018. The NDC end dates have been updated to reflect this:

- 46028-208-01 (UoS)
- 46028-208-02 (UoU)
- 46028-218-11 (UoU)
- 46028-219-11 (UoU)

In an attempt to better identify previously retired NDC codes, we have populated the NDC end date values for retired NDC codes that did not previously have an end date. The availability and source of the end date varies and may not always be explicitly available. The following describes the NDCs and the sources and decision logic used for the end date additions.
