

If Someone Gets Sick at School

These are the symptoms of Ebola. If you have any of these symptoms, call 115.



Fever



Diarrhea



Headache



Vomiting



Stomach Pain



Muscle Pain

Teachers and staff should know what to do if someone at school has a fever higher than 38°C.



Isolate and Contact

Keep the sick person at least 1 meter (3 feet) away from other students, teachers, and staff.

- Do not touch the sick person, blood, or body fluids.
- Remember to always wash your hands with soap and water.
- Contact family, if a student.



Ask and Alert

Find out if the sick person has been

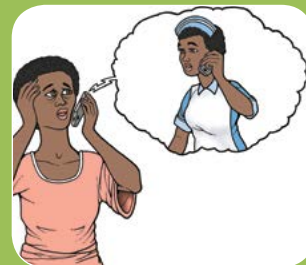
- Near someone who has had symptoms like Ebola.
 - Ask family to pick them up.
 - Call or have the family call 115.
- Told by health authorities that they have been around someone with Ebola.
 - Alert the closest Ebola response team.



Transfer

Ask for consent to transfer to Ebola Treatment Unit.

- If permission given, contact the response team.
- If permission not given, alert authorities.



Clean and Disinfect

Clean and disinfect the area according to cleaning guidance.
