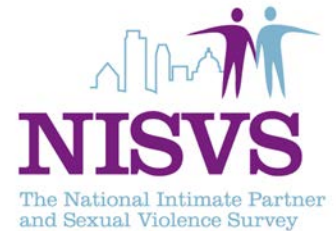


NISVS Customizable Insert Instructions



To help you communicate with partners and stakeholders about the National Intimate Partner and Sexual Violence Survey (NISVS) and its findings, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) developed the NISVS digest. The digest includes an overview of NISVS as well as inserts that provide key findings from each report and related special reports. To provide an option for localized content, CDC also developed a customizable insert that you can modify with state data and local prevention activities. The following provides instructions for using the customizable insert.

- The customizable insert is a Microsoft Word document to allow for easy editing. To get you started, CDC has provided suggested language for the insert. You can add to, edit, or remove this language to best fit your organization's needs and audiences, as you would in any other Microsoft Word document.
- The overview of NISVS at the bottom of the second page is locked from editing. We ask that you do not make changes to this language as it is CDC-approved language.
- To help populate the insert, you can access state-specific NISVS data on the CDC website: http://www.cdc.gov/violenceprevention/nisvs/state_tables.html. If you have questions about how to use this data, please email NISVSinfo@cdc.gov.
- We recommend changing the title of the insert to include your state name, e.g., "Intimate Partner Violence, Sexual Violence, and Stalking: A Snapshot of Massachusetts."
- We also recommend adding your organization's logo and contact information to the insert at the end of the second page. The customizable insert does not include the NISVS logo because items with the NISVS logo require CDC clearance. **Please do not add the NISVS logo to the insert.**
