

### Sortable Stats


Sortable Stats is an interactive data set comprised of 20 behavioral risk factors and health indicators. This data set compiles state-level data for the 50 states and D.C., from various published CDC and federal sources into a format that allows users to view, sort, and compare data by State, Geographic region, or Federal region. This tool is intended to serve as a resource in the promotion of policy, system, and environmental changes.

### Burden Assessments/Pareto Analyses

The site provides graphs that identify the extent to which each state contributes to the national public health burden. In many cases, a small number of states account for a large proportion of the burden (this is commonly known as the Pareto principle or the 80-20 rule).
