



Below you will find general program information related to members enrolled and members certified for treatment of health conditions in the WTC Health Program.




# Overall Enrollment: Responders and Survivors



**Note:** The Program started on July 1, 2011, and at that time, 54,211 Responders were “grandfathered” from previous Federal activities. On September 29, 2011, 4,770 Survivors were likewise “grandfathered”. The chart above depicts enrollment from the beginning of the Program, starting with “grandfathered” members and the cumulative addition of new members each quarter. The date labels correspond to the end of the quarter (i.e., July 2016 represents cumulative members through June 30, 2016).




# New Enrollees Responders and Survivors Past 12 Months









# WTC Health Program Member Type by Gender




# WTC Health Program Enrollment by State

# Members with Certifications by Zadroga Act Categories of Conditions




Individual members may have certifications in more than one category.

# Top 10 Certified Conditions


Individual members may have certifications for more than one condition.




