Active ingredient

Higher percentages of active ingredient provide longer protection

DEET

Picaridin (known as KBR 3023 and icaridin outside the US)

IR3535

Oil of lemon eucalyptus (OLE) or para-menthane-diol (PMD)

2-undecanone

Using Insect Repellent on Children

- **Always follow** the product label instructions.
- **Do not** use insect repellent on babies younger than 2 months old.
- **Do not** use products containing oil of lemon eucalyptus (OLE) or para-menthane-diol (PMD) on children under 3 months old.
- **Do not** put insect repellent on a child's hands, eyes, mouth, or cut or irritated skin.
- Adults: **Spray** insect repellent onto your hands and then apply to a child's face.
